<b>Location:</b>	Virtual & at Cedars Sinai Medical Center, Los Angeles, CA
<b>Compensation:</b>	For participation in Education in Action program, meetings and events & mileage compensation

<b>Approximate Hours Per Week:</b>	8-10 hours
<b>Description:</b>	<p>Under the expertise of Dr. Enrique López, an Oxy alum, seeking up to six bilingual Spanish proficient students to assist in an innovative community project that addresses a neurocognitive disorder that affects AIDS patients. Students' primary project will be to assist in the translation of a manual. However, students may have the opportunity to participate in a community support group.</p> <p><b>PROJECT OVERVIEW:</b> Dr. Lopez's plan is to create a community support group that assists caretakers or the patients, themselves, on strategies to address memory functions. His intervention plan is taken from Dr. Anthony Stickler from Emory University, Ecologically Oriented Neurorehabilitation of Memory (EON-MEM).</p> <p><b>DUTIES:</b> Work in dyads to translate modules from English to Spanish and Spanish to English. May have the opportunity to expand project based on needs and interest. In addition, this project might include providing assistance with and attending a community support group (would require a Saturday commitment). This is an excellent opportunity for students interested in any of the following fields: translation, public health, serving disenfranchise communities, neurocognitive disorders, mental health counseling and/or LGBT issues. Your assistance in this grant-funded project is crucial as you will be supporting Dr. Lopez with the development of this project.</p> <p>Also, please note that this opportunity is in collaboration with the Center for Community-Based Learning (CCBL), Spanish and Psychology departments at Oxy. Interns will be required to do additional assignments directed by the CCBL and Professor Guillén.</p>
<b>Qualifications:</b>	Fluency in Spanish, especially writing and speaking. Detailed-oriented and mature individuals. Sensitivity to illness and multicultural communities. Exposure to psychology field is preferred, but not required. Also, students who have taken Spanish 211 are preferred.
<b>Desired Majors:</b>	Psychology, Spanish Language, Cognitive Science, public health or pre-med bound
<b>Desired Class Year:</b>	Current Juniors or Seniors
<b>Additional Documents (clearance, certification):</b>	Selected interns will have to undergo a volunteer orientation set by Cedars-Sinai. In addition, the selected interns will be required to attend CCBL's Education In Action meetings. There will be readings and written reflections as assigned from the CCBL & Professor Guillén. Selected students will be required to enroll in INT 200 (2 unit internship course).
